Foster Home Information and Requirements

A foster home provides a temporary home for an animal until they are ready for adoption or are adopted. Many animals don't do well in the shelters, especially older pets. Often these pets don't show their true personalities while in the shelter and decline in health rapidly due to stress. By having these pets in foster homes, their true personalities can come out and they can be loved and cared for in the comfort of a real home while waiting to be adopted. By pulling these pets from the shelters, it helps the shelters take in more animals and save more lives. With the senior pets, it can be an extremely rewarding short term commitment that is a win-win situation for all!

Foster homes will be responsible for seeing to all the pet's needs including taking them to the vet and administering medicine when needed. Each agreement is different but generally OFSARNOF, Inc is responsible for providing everything a foster home needs to care for the foster. For those fosters who can provide food or supplies, it is greatly appreciated! The terms will be agreed upon in the signed Foster Home Agreement.

Requirements

- Foster parents must be at least 18 years old.
- Foster parents must keep their foster animal separated from their personal pets for the first 14 days.
- All dogs must be kept on a leash or supervised in an enclosed area when outside.
- All cats must be kept indoors at all times.
- All personal pets must be up to date on vaccinations or have current titers.
